## Common Access Card (CAC) Issuance & Name Changes

To issue or reissue a CAC, the following is required:

- 1. The DEERS/ID Card Center <u>CANNOT</u> change names in DEERS. Sponsor name changes are established and reported from the uniformed Service or Agency to DEERS as a verified record. The name change occurs within the <u>human resource personnel system</u>; an electronic data exchange to <u>DEERS</u> as an authoritative data feed, creating a verified record. <u>Family member name changes</u> are updated directly by the VO in RAPIDS to DEERS.
- 2. Military members who are married to a military member, referred to as Joint Service Marriage (JSM): The member's military personnel record needs to be updated by the respective Service's personnel data system to DEERS. Once the name change occurs in DEERS, then, RAPIDS reflects this information.
  - \*Note\* If there has been a name change, proof of name change <u>MUST</u> be presented and <u>MUST</u> be original.
    - a. Acceptable proof of name change documents:
      - (1) Marriage Certificate
      - (2) Divorce Decree
      - (3) Legal Name Change (Court Document)
- 3. You must present two (2) valid, unexpired, forms of identification listed in the Federal Information Processing Standards 201-2, and one form <u>MUST</u> be a photo ID. Active Duty Service Members please note: AN EXPIRED DRIVER'S LICENSE CANNOT BE USED FOR DEERS IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES.
- \*\*\* <u>CONTRACTORS</u> MUST PROVIDE TWO FORMS OF ID (ONE MUST BE A PHOTO) IN ADDITION TO THEIR CURRENT CAC, IN ORDER TO AVOID NOT BEING SERVICED BECAUSE CURRENT CAC HAS BEEN TERMINATED IN DEERS.
- \*Note\* Records for newly-hired employees are typically created between 3 to 7 business days from the start date. Please call in advance to check if the record is available in DEERS to issue a CAC.

- \*Note\* Discrepancies/corrections in the DEERS record such as citizenship, name change, date of birth, or gender MUST be updated by the Personnel Office prior to receiving the CAC.
- \*Note\* CACs can be renewed within <u>90 DAYS</u> prior to the expiration date. CACs are issued for a period of three years or less.
