U.S. v. Sergeant Bradley E. Darlington, Quantico, Virginia

4 June 15

At a general court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sergeant Bradley E. Darlington was convicted by military judge alone of failure to obey a lawful general order, assault, adultery, false official statements, wrongful distribution of a controlled substance and wrongful sale of military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to eleven years of confinement, reduction to E-1, total forfeitures, and a dishonorable discharge.

U.S. v. Sergeant Zachary A. Carrington, Norfolk, Virginia

5 June 15

At a special court-martial at Norfolk, Virginia, Sergeant Zachary A. Carrington was convicted by a panel of enlisted members of a lesser included offense of dereliction of duty. The panel awarded the accused no punishment.

U.S. v. Private Alexander C. Rowell, Norfolk, Virginia

16 June 15

At a special court-martial at Norfolk, Virginia, Private Alexander C. Rowell was convicted by a military judge of violating a general order, wrongful possession of a controlled substance with the intent to distribute and the drunken operation of a vehicle. The military judge sentenced the accused to 120 days confinement and a bad conduct discharge.
