**What does the acronym “AWANA” mean?** “AWANA” is an acronym for “Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed.” It is taken from 2 Timothy 2:15, which states, “Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth”.

**What do I do at AWANA?** Have fun at Game Time, Handbook Time, & Council Time!

- Game Time: Playing games on the unique AWANA Game Circle, kids have fun, get exercise, and learn good sportsmanship.
- Handbook Time: During Handbook Time, children progress through age-appropriate handbooks by memorizing and demonstrating an understanding of Bible passages.
- Council Time: The main feature of Council Time is a Bible-based lesson.
