# Green Belt Certification Requirements

- Complete USMC Green Belt course or comparable training through a university (e.g. Naval Post Graduate), federal agency, or professional provider.
- Lead a Project, an Event, or provide significant support of Black Belt Project.
- Project/Event to fulfill certification requirements
  - A Black Belt Mentor (Performance & Innovation (P&I) approved) :
    - Approves LSS Project/ or Rapid Improvement Event
    - Black Belt mentors Green Belt during the project/event
    - Black Belt provides P&I with recommendation for certification
  - Demonstrated use of Lean Six Sigma Tools
    - Black Belt determines tools based on project/event
    - Required tools-all projects/events
      - Project/Event Charter (BB Mentor signed)
      - Process/Value Stream Map
      - Final Tollgate
