## PERSONAL PROFILE

Staff Sgt. DelarosaBuglewicz joined the Marine Corps on December 18, 2006, as a 0300 infantryman. He became a 0311 rifleman in May 2007. Shortly after, he attended basic reconnaissance training where he graduated as a reconnaissance Marine in September 2007. He served with the 2d Reconnaissance Battalion based out of Camp Lejeune, N.C., and completed three deployments in a period of four years. He left active duty in September 2011 and joined the Marine Corps Reserves where he served with 4<sup>th</sup> Reconnaissance Battalion, Bravo Company, located in Atlanta, Ga., for three years. He was later activated and received orders to Wounded Warrior Battalion-East located in Camp Lejeune, N.C., and currently serve as a section leader for 2<sup>nd</sup> Platoon, Bravo Company.

During his deployments, he served on the 22nd MEU in Haiti and in Afghanistan during OEF X. During his third deployment, he was injured by an improvised explosive device (IED) and suffered a traumatic brain injury, as well as being diagnosed with PTSD. He also has many other injuries that have accumulated over the years from being a reconnaissance Marine.

Staff Sgt. DelarosaBuglewicz currently resides in North Carolina with his wife, Lindsey, and their two dogs and two cats. What he enjoys about the Warrior Games is the ability to compete with other service members.
