PERSONAL PROFILE

Staff Sgt. Shaw joined the Marine Corps in September 1997 as a 0311 rifleman. He served with the Marine Corps Security Force Company– Kings Bay 1998- 2000; 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines, 2000- 2002; Marine Corps Security Force Training Company 2002- 2005; 1st Light Armored Reconnaissance Battalion 2005-2008; Recruiting Station Pittsburgh 2008- 2010; and 1st Battalion, 2nd Marines, 2010-2013. Staff Sgt. Shaw deployed with the 11th Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU) with 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines; 15th MEU with 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines, to Iraq; 22nd MEU with 1st Battalion, 2nd Marines; and the 24th MEU with 1st Battalion, 2nd Marines. He was injured while in a light armored vehicle that rolled over during a 15th MEU workup for deployment, where he injured his back, neck, and head.

Staff Sgt. Shaw is currently with Wounded Warrior Battalion-East where he is getting ready to medically retire and transition into the civilian sector. What has had the greatest impact on his recovery has been the Warrior Athlete Reconditioning Program, specifically the cycling program. What he enjoys about the Warrior Games is camaraderie and a chance to test himself against other athletes from the different branches.
