

## PERSONAL PROFILE

Sgt. Smith joined the Marine Corps in October 2000 as a 0341 mortarman. He served with 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines, from 2000 to 2007 stationed at Camp Pendleton. After being wounded in Iraq in 2003 and again in 2006, he was injured stateside on his motorcycle. During his deployments, he received multiple concussions and severely injured his back. His motorcycle accident resulted in the amputation of his left leg and fusion of his right wrist. After his accident in 2007, he received orders to Wounded Warrior Battalion-West until the end of his active service in 2010.

Sgt. Smith currently resides in San Marcos, Calif., with his wife and five kids. His recovery has taken a long time, but he is grateful for the family and friends who have supported him. The Warrior Games mean a lot to him because it brings so many people together and they all strive for one thing, which is to do their best.
