Cpl. Storey joined the Marine Corps in July of 2007 as a 0311 infantryman. He served with 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines, based out of 29 Palms, California (MCAGCC). He deployed to Haditha, Iraq, from 2008-2009 with 3/7 India Company for his first tour overseas. He again deployed with 3/7 to Helmand Province, Afghanistan, in 2010 with Lima Company where he was promoted to team leader during deployment. Also during this deployment, he was injured by an improvised explosive device that severed his right leg and fractured his left fibula.

Cpl. Storey currently resides in San Diego with his service dog "Koja," working full time as night security officer. The hardest part of his recovery has been adapting to his new injury, but also overcoming his daily mental issues such as PTSD, depression, anxiety and other things. What he enjoys about the Warrior Games is the comradery and competitive nature.
