After 8 years, he then served with 2nd Battalion, 6th Marine Regiment, during which he deployed to Japan once and Iraq three times. During his third deployment, he was injured by eleven improvised explosive devices, one car bomb, and one rocket propelled grenade in a three month period.

Sgt. Wess currently resides in Hubbard, Ohio, with his wife Danielle and son Dylan. The hardest part of his recovery has been memory issues. The greatest impact on his recovery has been the love and support of his wife.
