U.S. v. Corporal Patrick M. Conner, Marine Corps Base, Quantico.

4 May 15

At a general court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Corporal Patrick M. Connor was convicted by military judge alone of false official statements, wrongful use of a controlled substance, larceny, and housebreaking. The military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 66 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a fine of \$4500.00.

U.S. v. Staff Sergeant Dustin A. Barker, Norfolk, Virginia

8 May 15

At a general court-martial at Norfolk, Virginia, Staff Sergeant Dustin A. Barker was convicted by members with enlisted representation of failure to obey a lawful general order and dereliction of duty. The members with enlisted representation sentenced the accused to reduction to E-5.

U.S. v. Lance Corporal Shane L. McDavid, Norfolk, Virginia

13 May 15

At a special court-martial at Norfolk, Virginia, Lance Corporal Shane L. McDavid was convicted by military judge alone of giving a false official statement and stolen property. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, reduction to E-1, and confinement for 60 days.

U.S. v. Corporal Dominic R. Lacato, Norfolk, Virginia

15 May 15

At a special court-martial at Norfolk, Virginia, Corporal Dominic R. Lacato was convicted by military judge alone of larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, reduction to E-1, and confinement for 90 days.

U.S. v. Corporal MCESG, MCB, Quantico, Virginia

22 May 15

At a general court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, a Corporal was acquitted by members with enlisted representation of rape

U.S. v. Staff Sergeant Benjamin A. Webb Quantico, Virginia

At a general court-martial, at Quantico, Virginia, a Staff Sergeant was convicted by members with enlisted representation of fraternization. The members with enlisted representation sentenced the accused with no punishment.
