U.S. v. Sergeant Stephen Karavolos, Quantico, Virginia

10 December 15

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sergeant Stephen Karavolos was convicted of attempted larceny, wrongful appropriation, larceny, dereliction of duty, violation of a lawful general order, false official statement, impersonating a noncommissioned officer, and impersonating a commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction to E-1, and confinement for 12 months. Per the pretrial agreement all confinement in excess of 6 months is suspended for 12 months.

U.S. Sergeant Carlos R. Urbina, Quatico, Virginia

16 December 15

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sergeant Carlos R. Urbina was convicted of operating a vehicle while drunk, operating a vehicle with revoked driving privileges, and false official document. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1. Per the pretrial agreement punitive discharge is disapproved. All confinement will be suspended for a period of 12 months after the date of the convening authority's action. All forfeitures will be suspended for a period of 12 months after the date of the convening authority's actions. The fine is disapproved.
