U.S. v. Private First Class Mykael B. McMahan, U.S. Marine Corps

5 April 2016

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Private First Class Mykael B. McMahan was convicted two specifications of making a false official statement and larceny by a military judge alone. He was sentenced to 90 days confinement, total forfeitures, reduction to E1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

U.S. v. HM2 James R. Allison, U.S. Navy

22 April 2016

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, HM2 James R. Allison was convicted of wrongfully distributing Adderall by a panel of members with enlisted representation. He was sentenced to 40 days restriction and a reduction to E4.

U.S. v. Staff Sergeant Aaron J. Weakley, U.S. Marine Corps

28 April 2016

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Staff Sergeant Aaron J. Weakley was convicted of 5 specifications of larceny by a military judge alone. He was sentenced to 5 months of confinement, a fine of \$5,000, forfeiture of \$1,000 for 5 months, and a reduction to E4.
