

U.S. v. Lance Cpl. William E. Trempe, Quantico, Virginia

Dec. 8, 2015

At a general court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Lance Cpl. William E. Trempe was convicted of committing a lewd act upon a child who had obtained the age of 12 years old but not attained the age of 15 years old and of communicating indecent language. The military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, reduction to E-1, and confinement for 18 months. Per the pretrial agreement, any confinement in excess of 300 days is suspended for the period of confinement served plus 12 months thereafter, and the dishonorable discharge will be mitigated to a bad conduct discharge.

U.S. v. Sgt. Stephen Karavolos, Quantico, Virginia

Dec. 10, 2015

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sgt. Stephen Karavolos was convicted of attempted larceny, wrongful appropriation, larceny, dereliction of duty, violation of a lawful general order, false official statement, impersonating a noncommissioned officer, and impersonating a commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction to E-1, and confinement for 12 months. Per the pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 6 months is suspended for 12 months.

U.S. Sgt. Carlos R. Urbina, Quantico, Virginia

Dec. 16, 2015

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sgt. Carlos R. Urbina was convicted of operating a vehicle while drunk, operating a vehicle with revoked driving privileges, and false official document. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-3, confinement for 89 days, and forfeiture of \$500 a month for 3 months. Per the pretrial agreement all confinement and adjudged forfeitures will be suspended for a period of 12 months from the date of the convening authority's action.
