U.S. V. Master Sergeant Brian E. Salked, U.S. Marine Corps

14 June 2016

At a special court martial at Quantico, Virginia, Master Sergeant Brian E. Salked was convicted by a military judge alone of two specifications of Article 92 Failure to disobey a lawful general regulation and violation of a lawful general order, Article 128 Assault consummated by battery, and Article 134 drunk and disorderly. He was reduced to E-7, fined \$4,220, and given a written reprimand.

U.S V. Sergeant Jesse L. Floyd, U.S. Marine Corps

28 June 2016

At a special court martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sergeant Jesse L. Floyd was convicted by a military judge alone of Article 107 False Official Statement and Article 134 Unlawfully entering a dwelling. He was sentenced to 75 days in confinement and reduction to E-3.
