U.S. v. Corporal Harold S. Quirama, Quantico, VA

At a general court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, on 6 November 2015, Corporal Harold S. Quirama was acquitted of all charges and specifications. These findings were reached by a panel of members with enlisted representation.

U.S. v. Staff Sergeant Lucas R. Eastman, Quantico, Virginia

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, on 17 November 2015, Staff Sergeant Lucas R. Eastman was convicted by military judge of violating a lawful general order, and false official statements. The military judge sentenced the accused to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction to E-3, and 30 days of confinement. Per the pretrial agreement any confinement will be disapproved upon the convening authority's action. All confinement awarded will be deferred. The period of deferment will run from the date of the sentence until the date of the convening authority actions on the sentence.
