U.S. v. Gunnery Sergeant Donnie C. Mullins Jr., New Orleans, LA

At a general court-martial at New Orleans, Louisiana, on 9 October 2015, Gunnery Sergeant Donnie C. Mullins Jr. was acquitted of all charges and specifications. These findings were reached by a panel of members with enlisted representation.

U.S. v. Corporal Christopher N. Graham, Quantico, VA

At a special court-martial at Quantico, Virginia, on 16 October 2015, Corporal Christopher N. Graham was convicted by military judge alone of wrongful use of heroin and wrongfully distributing heroin. The military judge sentenced the accused to a Bad Conduct Discharge, reduction to E-1, and 240 days of confinement.

US v Lance Corporal Jacob A. Laster, Quantico, VA

At a general court-marital at Quantico, Virginia, on 19 October 2015, Lance Corporal Jacob A. Laster was convicted by a panel of members with enlisted representation of sexual abuse of a child, indecent conduct, persuade, induce, entice, and coercing a minor to create child pornography. The panel of members sentenced the accused to a Dishonorable Discharge, reduction to E-1, Confinement for three years, and forfeitures of all pay and allowances.
