

Installation Restoration Program

Welcome to the Marine Corps Base (MCB) Quantico Installation Restoration (IR) Program page. The purpose of this page is to facilitate web-based communication between the public and the Department of Navy (DON) (and its contractors), United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). This web site provides access to numerous resources to ensure the continued success of IR Program activities at MCB Quantico.

The Environmental Restoration Program, formerly called the Installation Restoration Program, is a Department of the Navy (DoN) initiative to identify, investigate and clean up former waste disposal sites on military property. The objective is to reduce the risk to human health and the environment from past waste disposal operations and hazardous material spills in a cost-effective manner.

The Department of Defense follows industry-wide standard methods to dispose of wastes (e.g. solvents, waste oil, batteries, coal ash, wastewater sludge, etc.). In the past, solid wastes were typically deposited in low-lying areas and covered with soil. Over time, new federal regulations and approaches were developed for waste disposal (NAVFAC, 2013).

Documents available for public review:

During the environmental restoration process at an installation, certain documents are made available for public review and comment at certain stages of the cleanup. The public is encouraged to use these formal comment periods to submit comments on proposed cleanup choices; however, the Navy welcomes comments at any time on installation environmental restoration cleanup work.

The Installation Restoration Program Administrative Record, composed of documents related to the process of making decisions regarding the sites to be remediated under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) and the MCB Quantico IR Program, is publicly available to at the following locations:
