


Active Installation Restoration (IR) Sites

L-02 (Site 04) - Old Landfill



24 acre landfill located on banks of the Potomac River, operations began in the 1920's and closed in 1971.

Removal action's to date include: removal of soils/sediments, erosion/sediment control and on-going sampling/monitoring.



L-03 (Site 03) - DRMO Scrap-yard

2.5 acre yard, on top of Old Landfill used in the 1950s

Removal action's to date include: removal of contaminated soil/sediment and on-going sampling/monitoring.



Site 99 – Quantico Embayment

Watershed study for potential human health/ecological risks.

Removal action's to date include: removal of contaminated soil/sediment and on-going sampling/monitoring.



Site 100 – Chopawamsic Creek

Watershed study for potential human health/ecological risks.

Monitored natural recovery is in progress for sediment low level lead contaminants.



Site 102 – Abraham’s Creek

Watershed Study currently in progress.

Federal Facility Compliance Agreement

In 1998, the Department of the Navy (DON), Marine Corps, and regulatory agencies entered into a Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) for MCB Quantico. The FFA is a legally binding document that outlines the schedule for completing the investigation and clean up of sites at the Base. Parties to the FFA included the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, and the Department of the Navy (DON). The FFA specifies the working relationships among the Navy and each agency.
