

# **First Sergeant Jacquelynn E. Muncy**

## **Military Police Company First Sergeant**

1stSgt Muncy is originally from Valrico, Florida. She is the middle child of 2 brothers. In June 1998, she graduated from Bloomingdale Senior High School. 1stSgt Muncy joined the Marine Corps where she attended Recruit Training at Parris Island, South Carolina and was promoted to the rank of Private First Class. Upon graduating in October, she went on to Marine Combat Training at Camp Geiger, North Carolina, and then follow-on Marine Occupational Specialty (MOS) School, Camp Johnson, North Carolina, where she obtained the MOS 3043, Supply Administration.

January 1999, 1stSgt Muncy was assigned to 3d Marine Division, Headquarters Battalion Supply on Camp Courtney, Okinawa, Japan. During her tour there she held billets of supply clerk, fiscal clerk and garrison property chief. In March of 1999, she was promoted to the rank of Lance Corporal. In November 2000, she was then promoted to the rank of Corporal while serving as the supply clerk in the Battalion Motor Transport Platoon. She successfully completed Corporal's Leadership Course in September 2001.

In June 2002, she was then assigned to the Inspector-Instructor Staff at 4th Assault Amphibian Battalion in Tampa, Florida. There, she held the billet of Fiscal Chief. In July of 2002, she was promoted to the rank of Sergeant.

In July 2005, 1stSgt Muncy attended Drill Instructor School. She graduated in September, receiving the MOS of 8511, Drill Instructor. She was then assigned to 4th Recruit Training Battalion, November Company in October 2005. During that time, she was promoted to the rank of Staff Sergeant. In July 2008, she was reassigned to Oscar Company and assigned the billet as the Series Gunnery Sergeant. 1stSgt Muncy successfully completed three years as a Drill Instructor, Experienced Drill Instructor and Senior Drill Instructor. During this 3 years, 9 months were on quota as a Drill Instructor of Recruit Separations Platoon.

October 2008, 1stSgt Muncy was transferred to Consolidated Material Support Center, Headquarters Battalion, Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center, 29 Palms where she held the billet as the Supply Chief for the

next 2 years. On Jan 1, 2010 she was promoted to the rank of Gunnery Sergeant.

In January 2011, 1stSgt Muncy transferred to Supply Company, 1st Supply Battalion, Combat Logistics Regiment 15 as the Company Gunnery Sergeant. 1stSgt Muncy deployed with 12.1 1st Maintenance Battalion (-) REIN as the Supply Company Gunnery Sergeant. Upon returning from deployment, 1stSgt Muncy was transferred to Medical Logistics Company within 1st Supply Battalion and served as the Company First Sergeant.

In April 2014, 1stSgt Muncy transferred to Security Battalion, to be the Company First Sergeant for Military Police Company where she is currently serving.

1stSgt Muncy's personal awards consist of one Navy Commendation Medal and three Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal. She is married to MGySgt Adam Muncy, originally from Columbus, Ohio, who is assigned to the Pentagon; they have a 5 month old daughter named Adalynn.
