Subj: INTEGRATED CULTURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. An Integrated Cultural Resource Management Plan (ICRMP) is a planning, decision, and situational awareness document for Commanders on Marine Corps Installations to make informed decisions on the management of cultural resources located on Marine Corps bases.

- 2. The ICRMP is based on Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 4715.16, Cultural Resources Management, Department of Defense (DoD) Measures of Merit, Secretary of the Navy Instruction (SECNAVINST) 4000.35A, Department of the Navy Cultural Resources Program, and Marine Corps Order (MCO) 5090.2A (Change 2, Chapter 8). The ICRMP is a multi-year plan that supports the military training mission by identifying compliance actions required by applicable federal laws and regulations concerning cultural resources management.
- 3. The ICRMP is specifically related to Marine Corps Installations National Capital Region-Marine Corps Base Quantico's cultural resources and contains Standard Operating Procedures to aid Commanders in the event that they, or members of their chain of command, inadvertently discover human remains or artifacts that appear to be historic in nature.
