Disabled American Veteran (DAV) 100% - DEERS Enrollment

To enroll a 100% Disabled Veteran and eligible family members in DEERS, the following documents are required:

- Veteran's Eligibility Letter from the Veterans Affairs showing eligibility. The letter MUST read
 that the veteran is 100% permanently disabled, unemployable, or is 100% temporarily disabled
 WITH a reevaluation date (or stating no scheduled reevaluation), and that commissary and
 exchange privileges are authorized.
- 2. Two (2) valid, unexpired, forms of identification listed in the Federal Information Processing Standards 201-2, and one form MUST be a photo ID.
- 3. Veteran's DD Form 214 (Member 4 copy) to verify honorable discharge and service information.
- 4. Veteran's Birth Certificate (Original copy with file number).
- 5. Veteran's Social Security Card (Original, not laminated).
- *Note* The Veteran and eligible dependents receive an ID card for Commissary, Exchange, and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) privileges ONLY.
- *Note* The Veteran and eligible dependents are NOT entitled to Tricare/Medical privileges. The Veteran and eligible dependents are eligible to receive medical benefits through the Department of Veteran Affairs Civilian Health and Medical Program.
- *Note* DAV Status cannot be added to DEERS for those who already have a Retired, reserve retired, or reserve status under their record. Doing so would cause data errors effecting Tricare benefits.
