

Disabled American Veteran 100% - DEERS Enrollment

To enroll a 100% Disabled Veteran and eligible family members in DEERS, the following documents are required:

1. Veteran's Eligibility Letter from the Veterans Affairs showing eligibility. The letter MUST read that the veteran is 100% permanently disabled, unemployable, or is 100% temporarily disabled WITH a reevaluation date. These veterans are eligible for Commissary, Exchange, and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) privileges.
2. Two (2) valid, unexpired, forms of identification listed in the Federal Information Processing Standards 201-2, and one form MUST be a photo ID.
3. Veteran's DD Form 214 (Member 4 copy) to verify discharge and service information.
4. Veteran's Birth Certificate (Original copy with file number).
5. Veteran's Social Security Card (Original, not laminated).

Note *The Veteran and eligible dependents receive an ID card for Commissary, Exchange, and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) privileges ONLY.*

Note *The Veteran and eligible dependents are NOT entitled to Tricare/Medical privileges. The Veteran and eligible dependents are eligible to receive medical benefits through the Department of Veteran Affairs Civilian Health and Medical Program.*
