

ATTENTION HUNTERS, FISHERMEN, AND WOODCUTTERS: PLEASE READ REGARDING NEW BASE ACCESS PROCEDURES:

Marine Corps Base Quantico (MCBQ) has implemented the DoD mandated Physical Access Control System, Defense Biometric Identification System (DBIDS).

This new system focuses on access control procedures to ensure the protection of Active Duty personnel, residents and civilian employees. These policies are intended to help Marines accomplish their mission and keep families aboard the installation safe, while allowing access to authorized personnel, contractors & vendors and sponsored visitors.

In order to access the installation for hunting, fishing, and/or woodcutting you must have an approved credential. You must have one of the following credentials: Common Access Card (CAC), TESLIN (Dependent, Retiree, IRR-Reservist), Federal PIV Card (TWIC, FBI, DEA, DHS), or DBIDS Card.

I do not have one of the above approved cards but would like to hunt, fish, or woodcut at MCBQ. Now what?

If you do not already have an approved card, you will need to obtain DBIDS card in order to gain authorized access to MCBQ. Hunters, fishermen, and woodcutters will have their identity proofed & vetted, and be issued an appropriate DBIDS card at no cost. You must obtain a DBIDS card at the Provost Marshal Office, 2043 Barnett Avenue, Quantico, VA. As a courtesy to the hunting community, hunters who were previously subjected to a background check (most of the “Brown” category license holders) and have a current MCBQ hunting license have been pre-vetted by the Provost Marshal Office-this should help expedite your wait time. However, you still must pre-enroll in the DBIDS system and then obtain a DBIDS card. Some “Brown” category license holders who were not previously subjected to a background checks (such as those with law enforcement credentials) will now be required to be vetted. Total processing time may be up to 10 days.

PROCESS FOR OBTAINING DBIDS CARD:

- 1) Begin enrollment process at: <https://dbids-global.dmdc.mil/enroll#!/> For hunting, fishing, or woodcutting use “Natural Resources” for your sponsor’s last name and “NREA” for your sponsor first name with email address “quan_sac@usmc.mil” and phone number “703-784-4030”.
- 2) Bring the confirmation code or printout AND photo ID (such as Driver’s License, State ID, Passport) to the Provost Marshal Office, 2043 Barnett Avenue. This can be accomplished 0700-1500 Monday-Friday.

Hunters, Fishermen, and Woodcutters without a CAC, TESLIN, DBIDS, or PIV card will be denied access to MCBQ for hunting, fishing, or woodcutting, For more information regarding DBIDS go to: <https://www.quantico.marines.mil/Base-Access/>
