U. S. v Petty Officer Second Class Jaime E. Laramata

6 April 2018

At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, Petty Officer Second Class Jaime E. Laramata was convicted by a military judge of seven specifications of Article 120– Abusive Sexual Contact.

The military judge sentenced the accused to a Dishonorable Discharge, total forfeitures, reduction to E-1, and 30 months confinement.

Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, all confinement over 2 years will be suspended for the period of confinement adjudged plus 12 months thereafter, at which time, unless sooner vacated, the suspended portion will be remitted without further action.

US v First Sergeant Larry M. Coon

26 April 2018

At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, First Sergeant Larry M. Coon was convicted by a panel of enlisted and officer members of one specification of Article 128 – Assault Consummated by Battery Upon a Child Under 16 Years, two specifications of Article 134 – Adultery, one specification of Article 134 – Violating a Lawful Protective Order, one specification of Article 134 – Obstruction of Justice, one specification of Article 134 – Child Endangerment.

The panel of enlisted and officer members sentenced the accused to be reduced to E-6, forfeitures of \$1000 per month for one month, and 60 days of confinement

There was no pre-trial agreement in the case.
