- 1. <u>Situation</u>. The dates of recognized Federal holidays outlined in enclosure (1) can be found at the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) website. The OPM publishes changes to the dates on which recognized Federal holidays are to be observed, as authorized by Presidential Executive Orders.
- 2. <u>Mission</u>. To promulgate policy for the observance of Federal holidays. Publication of this Bulletin is intended to achieve consistency in the holiday routine designated for Marine and civilian employees assigned to Marine Corps Installations National Capital Region-Marine Corps Base Quantico (MCINCR-MCBQ), and facilitate long-range personal planning.

## Execution

a. <u>Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations</u>. I expect leaders and supervisors of MCINCR-MCBQ organizations to afford our military and civilian personnel the maximum opportunity for time off to safely enjoy the Federal holidays. Leave and liberty should be granted consistent with mission requirements in a liberal manner that is equitable and fair to all.

### b. Subordinate Element Missions

- (1) Commanding Officers shall authorize leave and/or liberty for military personnel to celebrate the Federal holidays in accordance with the references (a), (b), (c), and (d) as applicable;
- (2) Authorized leave in addition to holiday leave for civilian personnel to celebrate the Federal holidays in accordance with reference (e);
- (3) Close of business (COB) will be defined by the Commanding Officers, starting no earlier than noon on the prescribed day.

## 4. Administration and Logistics

- a. All Officers, Staff Non-Commissioned Officers in Charge, and supervisors will conduct the appropriate safety briefs and vehicle inspections prior to departure for holiday liberty.

Memorial Day (Monday, 29 May 2023) Liberty period = COB, Friday, 26 May - 0730, Wednesday, 31 May

Juneteenth (Monday, 19 June 2023) Liberty period = COB, Friday, 16 Jun - 0730, Tuesday, 20 Jun

Independence Day (Tuesday, 4 July 2023)
Liberty period = COB, Friday, 30 Jun - 0730, Wednesday, 5 Jul

Labor Day (Monday, 4 September 2023) Liberty period = COB, Friday, 1 Sep - 0730, Wednesday, 6 Sep
