Legal Custody Ward – DEERS Enrollment

Cross-Servicing regulations may prevent our center from initial enrollment of dependent ***Please contact the DEERS Office if you need more information***

To enroll a Legal Custody Ward in DEERS, the following documents are required:

- <u>Every ID issuance</u> requires that the sponsor is present <u>OR</u> a Power of Attorney must be presented and signed by the sponsor <u>OR</u> sponsor may complete the DD Form 1172-2 with an official notary <u>OR</u> the sponsor may complete the DD Form 1172-2 on the Rapids Self-Service website: <u>https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/</u>. A dependent ID card will be issued for four (4) years or less and can be renewed within <u>90 DAYS</u> prior to the expiration date.
- 2. Approval of Dependency Determination (DD 1172-2) from Service Branch Project Office <u>OR</u> Defense Finance Accounting Services (DFAS)
- 3. Original Court Order establishing child is in the sponsor's custody for 12 months or more.
- 4. Child's Birth Certificate (Original, with file number).
- 5. Child's Social Security Card (Original, not laminated).
- 6. Child over age 18 Two (2) valid, unexpired, forms of identification that are listed in the Federal Information Processing Standards 201-2, and one form MUST be a photo ID.

Note Recertification – The sponsor <u>MUST</u> have the Recertification of the Dependency Determination from DFAS every four (4) years or less. The sponsor may submit the application for Recertification of the Dependency Determination within 90 days of expiration.

Note Children who are married or joined active military service are no longer eligible for benefits under the sponsor.

Note For Active Duty and Reserve Marines, please ensure you visit the IPAC to enroll dependent(s).
