

Disabled American Veteran (DAV) 100% - DEERS Enrollment

To enroll a 100% Disabled Veteran and eligible family members in DEERS, the following documents are required:

1. Veteran's Eligibility Letter from the Veterans Affairs showing eligibility. The letter **MUST** read that the veteran is 100% permanently disabled, unemployable, or is 100% temporarily disabled **WITH** a reevaluation date (or stating no scheduled reevaluation), and that commissary and exchange privileges are authorized.
2. Two (2) valid, unexpired, forms of identification listed in the Federal Information Processing Standards 201-2, and one form **MUST** be a photo ID.
3. Veteran's DD Form 214 (Member 4 copy) to verify honorable discharge and service information.
4. Veteran's Birth Certificate (Original copy with file number).
5. Veteran's Social Security Card (Original, not laminated).

Note The Veteran and eligible dependents receive an ID card for Commissary, Exchange, and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) privileges **ONLY**.

Note The Veteran and eligible dependents are **NOT** entitled to Tricare/Medical privileges. The Veteran and eligible dependents are eligible to receive medical benefits through the Department of Veteran Affairs Civilian Health and Medical Program.

Note DAV Status cannot be added to DEERS for those who already have a Retired, reserve retired, or reserve status under their record. Doing so would cause data errors effecting Tricare benefits.
