

## **Invitation for Public Comment**

Marine Corps Base Quantico (MCBQ) is proposing to shore up a failed interior column, to replace the failed column, to replace exterior doors to meet current fire protection codes, and to make repairs to the building envelope at Building 3045, which is a contributing resource within the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP)-listed Quantico Marine Corps Base Historic District (Virginia Department of Historic Resources [DHR] ID: 287-0010). Building 3045 historically served as an ordnance field maintenance shop within the industrial portion of the historic district, and it still serves this function today. The purpose of this undertaking is to repair the building so that it remains safe for continued use, thus allowing it to serve its mission purpose and to remain a contributing resource within the historic district.
