U. S. v Sergeant Brian R. Marinaro

5 December 2017

At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, Sergeant B. R. Marinaro was convicted by a military judge of Article 121 – Wrongful appropriation. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement, forfeiture of \$1500 per month for a period of 4 months, and reduction to E-4.

The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

U. S. v Sergeant Tara E. Hudson

7 December 2017

At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, Sergeant T. E. Hudson was convicted by a military judge of three specifications of Article 86:

- Absence from unit, organization, or place of duty for more than 3 days
- Absence from unit, organization, or place of duty for more than 30 days,
- Absence from unit, organization, or place of duty for more than 30 days

Two specifications of Article 89:

- Disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer
- Disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer

Six specifications of Article 91:

- Contempt toward a superior non-commissioned officer
- Willful disobedience a superior non-commissioned officer

and Article 107 – False official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.

There was no pre-trial agreement in this case.

U. S. v Sergeant Israel Torres

20 December 2017

At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a Sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of Articles 128 – Assault consummated by a battery, 134 – Animal abuse, and 134 – Threat, communicating.

There was no pre-trial agreement in this case.
